It's amazing to see each year how many baseball fans tour professional baseball stadiums throughout the United States. Most first-time visitors say they were pleasantly surprised by our museum. It is truly a blessing to be a part of a group that is dedicated to preserving the rich history of baseball here on the Eastern Shore. We are so grateful to Mr. Frank Perdue for his vision of the museum and for the original board of directors, members and countless men and women and local businesses that helped launch our museum.
