FRANK "HOMERUN" BAKER - PLAYER (INDUCTED 1995)



discovered by Connie Mack. His contract was purchased after two months by the Athletics, Eastern Shore and earned renown as a semi-pro player in the nearby town of Cambridge. Frank Baker was born on March 13, 1886 in the small town of Trappe on Maryland's In 1908 he played for the Reading Pretzels in the Tri-State League where he was who owned a large part of the Reading team.

Major League Baseball from 1908 to 1922, for the Philadelphia Athletics and the New York Frank was an American professional baseball player. A third baseman, Baker played in Yankees. Baker has been called the "original home run king of the majors"

During his 13 years as a major league player, Baker never played a single inning at any over the years, and he is regarded by many as one of the best power hitters of the deadball Baker led the American League in home runs for four consecutive years, from 1911 through 1914. He had a batting average over .300 in six seasons, had three seasons with more than position other than third base.
