Modest Town-Mr. Robert Watson Wessells, 86, husband of Peggy Bundick Wessells and a resident of Modest Town, Va., formerly of Bloxom, Va., passed away at his home on Sunday, August 21, 2016.

Born February 8, 1930 in Bloxom, he was a son of the late Harry Thomas Wessells and Willie Mae Hart Wessells. Bobby graduated from Bloxom High School; was a devoted member of Modest Town Baptist Church, where he was a Deacon for 57 years, Past Clerk serving 34 years, and Past Sunday School Superintendent; and was a Telemetry Supervisor with NASA, retiring in 1987 following more than 38 years of service.
